Do you have beginner riders & riders on leads that would love to give games a go but are a little worried about the fast pace of the competition teams?

Let's encourage all our riders and enter them into the Assisted Games in 2016.

Under 12 Beginners & led riders only.

Fill out the Assisted part on the entry with the amount of riders you have wanting to participate and we will make teams of 6 on the day. There is no need to fill a team for this section.

This is NOT a competition, it's a participation day for this group of riders to expose them to the thrill of games riding and team events.



And for the regular games teams – remember that **composite teams** are welcome and are eligible to go to State. So if your club has half a team of keen riders, don't give up. Contact Niree who will find another club with half a team.

New in 2017 Team of 2, 3 or 4 Musical ride!

This is for the riders that want to have a go but can't find a full team of four riders or just want to compete at zone level without the pressure of going to state. You must have a minimum of 2 riders up to a maximum of 4. Yes you can compete with 3.

Same rules apply as the team of 4 musical ride although the 2, 3, 4 musical will not be eligible for State Competition.

Games Events

- 1. Bending / Baton Relay
- 2. 2 Mug Shuffle Relay
- 3. Bottle Race
- 4. Sock & bucket
- 5. Stick pegging
- 6. Flag and Drum Relay (at State level flags will not be attached to the poles)

These games are the same as those which will be run at the PCV State Championships on Saturday and Sunday 25th and 26th November, 2017. The rules are in the booklet which is published on the PCV website.

Assisted teams will participate in all 6 games events against other assisted teams. The assisted teams WILL NOT compete against the competition teams and are not eligible for State Championships.

Flat and Musical Ride Teams

These competitions will be run using the same format as for the PCV State Championships on Saturday and Sunday 25th and 26th November, 2017. The rules are in the booklet which is published on the PCV website. Note that the new event added in 2014 will continue; A Flat Team of Two or Pairs test will be judged separately to the Flat Team of Four.

Riders may enter any two of the Flat Team of Four, the Flat Team of Two or the Musical ride, but not all three.

LATE NEWS ON THE OCTOBER RALLY



FINISH AT 2PM APPROXIMATLEY.


