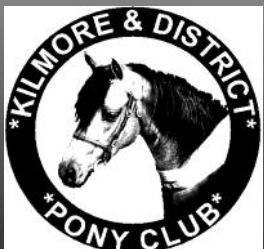

Membership 2017/2018 Renewal Now Open via MyPonyClub Instructions for use.

Fees Junior - \$340 and Associate/Senior - \$360

Access the MyPonyClub database by going onto the PCAV website <http://www.ponyclubvic.org.au/>

and on the left hand side you will see Omnisportsmanagement

1. Click on Member Log In
2. You will come to a Log In page.
3. If you know your Pony Club ID (which is your pony club number which you will find on your Pony Club Card) pop it in and create a password.
4. If you don't know your ID number leave them blank and it will bring up a small box where you put in your details to receive your Pony Club ID. If you are new to pony club you can create a new membership and receive a pony club ID.
5. Follow the prompts and then you should be able to log in.
6. To pay your fees for 2017/2018 select my membership and it will show your details, select the renew option and it will provide details to make your payment to Kilmore PC either via EFT or by cheque.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS FOR 2017/2018 HAVE ARRIVED

All pony club members are issued with a membership card from the PCAV (Pony Club Association of Victoria) each year. This is each rider's PCAV club membership record and establishes that the rider is also registered with PCAV. The card must be kept **up to date** and accurately completed by the Secretary, Card Secretary and DC.

The card contains information such as your name, address, date of birth and the name of your horse/s. We also record your rally attendance. Only the DC or Card Secretary may sign the Attendance Record page. When you would like to go out and represent the club at a pony club competition, you first need to be graded. The DC does the grading and these details will be recorded in your Membership card, including the date you were graded, on which horse and the grade. eg Grade 5 (for beginners). The DC must sign the grading.

The DC, Secretary or Card Secretary have these cards and they are available at the club every rally.

It is important that the card is kept up to date and it is the Members' responsibility to make sure that their card is complete and in your possession before attending a competition.

Check with the DC (Cathy Dingwall), Secretary (Shan Rees) or Card Secretary (To Be Advised) to ensure it has been fully completed. If you have any questions regarding cards, please just let us know. We are more than happy to help. You can also find information on the PCAV website.
